# Recipe of the Month Strawberry Pizza

1 package of refrigerated cookie dough

8oz cream cheese. Softened

1/2 teaspoon vanilla

 $1/2 \ {\rm cup} \ {\rm sugar}$ 

2 cups sliced strawberries

#### <u>Glaze:</u>

1cup mashed strawberries

4 tablespoons sugar

1 tablespoon cornstarch

- 1. press cookie dough onto a baking sheet. Bake according to directions on package. Cool.
- 2. Beat cream cheese, vanilla, and sugar until fluffy.
- 3. Spread filing over crust.
- 4. Spread strawberries over the filing.
- 5. Cook the mashed strawberries, sugar and cornstarch until clear.
- 6. Spread over sliced strawberries.
- 7. Cool.



If you have been watching the ads on TV, you may know that February is the month of the XXI Winter Olympic Games. It will be your opportunity to obtain a QSL card to remember the event. Four years ago, Italy had fifteen special call signs, one for each event. At the end of those games, as tradition dictated, The Olympic Flag was given to the mayor of Vancouver and has been on display in the City Hall since. In 2008 at the completion of the 2008 Summer Olympics, the Olympic Torch was passed to Canada and it was embodied with the issuing of a special QSL Card during the CQ WPX and the ARRL DX contests.

The Games again are going to be honored by a special event station using the call sign VG7G. The event is sponsored by the Vancouver Amateur Radio Group (VOARG). Bill, VE7XS, will be point man for this event and the station will be on the air from February 1st until March 31st. The station will celebrate the XXI Olympic Winter Games, February 12-28, and the X Paralympic Winter Games, March 12-21.
