

Field Day

(1) affix the proclamation copy to every Field Day station across the state on Field Day weekend. We want every visitor and every Field Day operator to see it.

(2) but first, at the suggestion of Ohio State Government Liaison Nick Pittner, K8NAP, please take the document to leaders of your local government - mayors, city councils, county commissioners, school boards, and see if you can get a similar proclamation from them. This has to be done immediately. These officials have to meet in session within the next three weeks to pass such a resolution.

As mayors, city councils and county governments issue these proclamations, please keep us informed and, if possible, send us a copy of their proclamation. SGL Pittner said this is easily done since the local offi-

cials will surely use the same language as Governor Strickland and it is free publicity for them not to pass up. But ham radio leaders, you have to act quickly on this.
