According to State Government Liaison Nick Pittner, K8NAP, we need to have the Public Safety and Homeland Security Committee move House Bill 212 out of their committee, so it can be ready to go when Senate Bill 218 arrives to the House Floor. Our window of opportunity is closing, and we must get these Bills voted on before the Summer recess, which begins on July 1, 2010. At this time, phone calls to the committee members offices, either speaking with the Representative directly, or their assistant/aide is what we

RECIPE OF THE MONTH - CREAMY PARMESAN PASTA SALAD

Ingredients:

3 1/2 cups bowtie pasta, uncooked
 2 cups pea pods
 2 large red bell peppers chopped
 2 medium carrots chopped
 1/2 cup chopped basil leaves
 1/2 cup shredded parmesan cheese
 1 cup light creamy Caesar dressing
 2 tablespoons milk

Directions:

1. cook and drain pasta as directed on the package, adding pea pods for last minute of cooking.
2. Meanwhile, mix bell peppers, carrots, basil and cheese in a very large (4 quart) bowl. Mix dressing and milk in a small bowl with wire whisk. Add dressing mixture, pasta and pea pods to bell pepper mixture; toss to coat.
